DETEX V40 SERIES – (above) the preferred solution. Pressure against the panic bar opens the door, setting off a 95-dB alarm.

Panic touch bar with vertical locking rods – can be used on single doors – or to secure the fixed leaf of double doors

DETEX ECL-600 - for narrower doors
Pressure against the push pad opens the door, setting off a 95-dB alarm
