### **HINGES WITH HINGE-PINS FOR TIMBER DOORS**

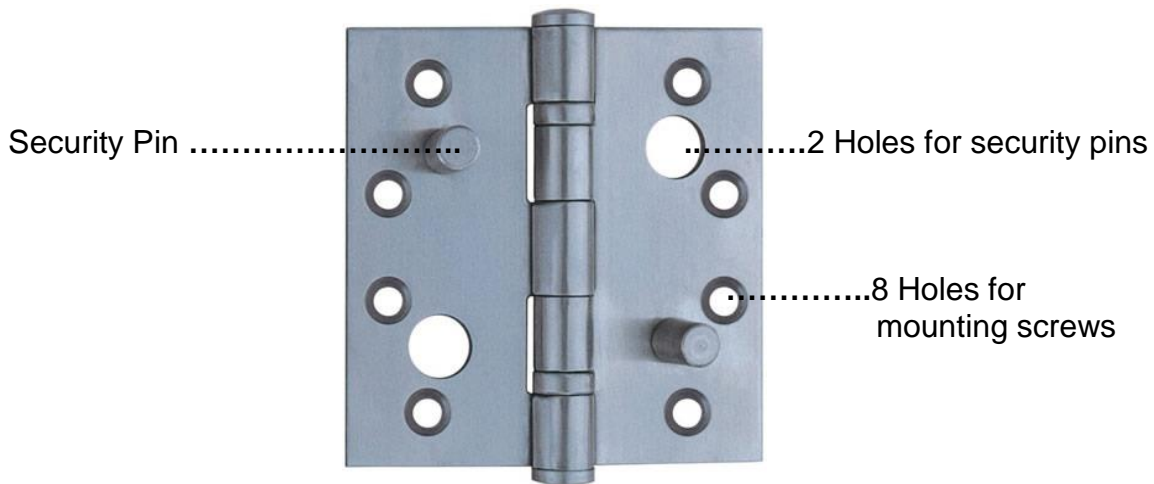
Hinge wear causes a door to sag, often to the extent that it touches the door frame or the floor, and will no longer close or open properly. This can cause damage to the lock or emergency exit hardware, the door and / or the frame. If left in this condition the door can become unusable – which could pose a danger if occupants are unable to escape from the building.

Hinges with ball bearings are inherently better than the old fashioned brass hinges with nylon, steel or bronze washers, which have hinge pins that can be knocked out with force and a little skill.

Good quality ball-bearing hinges have protected hinge-pins, are stronger and less prone to wear, and generally comply with British or CE Standards.

A more secure innovation is the Ball Bearing Security Hinge:

These 100 x 75 mm hinges are made of high quality 3.0 mm stainless steel, in either bright silver finish or a PVD brass finish, which has an exceptionally long life.



When the hinge is closed, the two security pins are locked into the corresponding hole on the opposite leaf, to resist lifting and levering of the door when in the closed position.

All eight mounting holes should be used, and all screws should be tight and flush with the hinge.
